

Mobile Solar Stage

Terms & Conditions

Contract

We will need sufficient time to enter a venue and set up prior to the start time with a similar, but smaller time allowance at the end. Set up time can be considerably reduced if access is good and any other instructions clear and concise.

If you are booking other entertainment, please consider & think about the amount of space available and where our stage and truck is to be located. It is the hirers responsibility to ensure there is enough space for our equipment at the site/ venue, see the P.D.F on our website, site requirements. If your unsure and a site visit is necessary it will be at the cost of the hirer

The ground where the stage is to be set needs to be reasonably level with no potholes or manhole covers or other obstacles and needs to be unshaded for our solar array to operate see site requirements on website.

The versatility of our mobile stage is such that it can be erected on grass, however, if the ground is too soft we will be at risk of bogging down while towing the stage into position. In such circumstances it is at the discretion of the driver as to whether or not to drive onto the grass. If the decision is made to go ahead, it is the responsibility of the organiser to provide any towing/tracking aides as necessary both on arrival and at time of departure.

We reserve the right to refuse to continue any event should there be insufficient space on arrival which would not allow our stage/solar generator truck to be assembled safely, or conditions which could make the final assembly unsafe. This also applies at the risk of working within wet or damp conditions at the location, which as a result may endanger the electrical safety regulations.

Any crowd barriers security/policing for the front of the stage/generator truck are the responsibility of the hirer

All equipment that is used is checked prior to arrival & has been fully PAT tested for safety. We reserve the right to substitute alternative equipment from that specified should uncontrollable circumstances on our part dictate the need to do so. If our electrical engineer deems any electrical equipment unsafe we will not allow it to be used as this could affect our public liability.

If we are linking our equipment within a fixed in-house audio system, we may reserve the right to refuse to do so if the equipment is considered by ourselves to be unsafe or liable to cause damage to any linked component.

The hirer / booker is responsible for any damage to equipment caused by any person at the event. You will be advised of any damage caused, and will be charged for the full cost of any repairs required.

We will not be responsible for any damage or loss to private or public property caused by invited guests or members of the public. We do not tolerate violent, aggressive or abusive behaviour from anyone under any circumstances. We also reserve the right to terminate our services at any time our personal safety is under threat.

In the event of fire, flooding, public disturbance, terrorist activity or any other threat to the public, we will not be responsible to help in any way or evacuate any venue or building where we are present and / or working within, unless the fire regulations for the venue specify otherwise. This would usually incur a vocal announcement.

We depend on sunlight to run our stage so our generator truck that houses our solar array and tracking system needs to be positioned in an unshaded area away from trees buildings or any other obstacles. Ideally we would be positioned south facing but can adjust or tracker to suit all locations if required.

All bookings should be taken on the understanding that the venue is in possession of the necessary entertainment license/temporary events licence and or any other relevant paperwork. We are not responsible if the venue is found to be in breach of the terms and conditions of their license .

We require 50% of the booking fee on acceptance of our terms and conditions the balance to be paid in full when all hired equipment is set and ready for the hirer to use.

We advise all who have booked well in advance to contact us more than 14 days prior to the event. This is to ensure that your plans have not changed & keeps us informed of any special instructions or last minute requirement.

Any cancellations or notified changes must be made at least 21 days prior to the date of the event in writing. If we receive more than 14 but less than 21 days notice of cancellation, the hirer is liable to pay 50% of an agreed fee. If we receive less than 14 days notice of cancellation, the hirer is liable to pay the whole of an agreed fee.

Failed payment of any fees owed within 21 days after the date of the event will result in pending legal action

We have never cancelled or failed to turn up to an event we have been engaged to cover. In the unprecedented event that we cannot fulfil an engagement our liability is limited to arranging alternative hire subject to a maximum fee we have arranged with the hirer.

We cannot accept liability for any other direct or consequential losses.

Acceptance of our terms and conditions and the deposit forms a binding contract between us and the hirer and shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with English law. The English courts shall have jurisdiction to resolve any disputes between us.

We reserve the right to alter any or all of the above at any time.
